I am excited and looking forward to starting a new supervision group for qualified practitioners. I think group supervision is an incredibly rich and valuable experience. I am a very experienced counsellor/trainer and counsellor/psychotherapist (one-to-one; couple/sex therapy; adults and U-18s); also qualified and very experienced in one-to-one *and* group supervision for practitioners in a wide range of contexts. My supervisory approach is facilitative and supportive, rather than authoritarian or directive, but with manageable challenge. I also welcome the use of creative approaches to thinking about our work.

Group details:

- For counsellors, psychotherapists and clinical psychologists (or similar) working in a variety of settings
- Starting September: day/time to be negotiated from the following
 - Monday morning or afternoon
 - Thursday morning
 - Friday morning or afternoon
 - Fortnightly or possibly monthly*
 - Duration negotiable -1.5 hours* or 2-3 hours monthly
- Membership 4-8 per group
- Expectation of a minimum commitment to attend (6 months)
- Cost (paid monthly in advance) dependent on group size, but indicative figure is £12.50 per person per session. Initial planning/discussion meeting free and without obligation.

* Timing/duration is designed to complement one hour per month individual supervision to meet BACP's required 1.5 hours per month, but is open to negotiation by, and in response to the needs of the group.
